It's time to look forward to Spring.

Spring 2021 is nearly here:

It's an exciting time in the garden despite the cold and often dull days. But when the sun is shining it's a very positive place to be.

Just looking closely will reveal how nature has been quietly and discreetly working away, whilst allowing buds to develop, shoots to appear and early flowers to bloom.

Just a small change in the garden can bring a huge amount of delight and joy.



Potted Spring bulbs and Bulb collections:

Our range of potted [Spring bulbs](#) planted in peat free compost and 9cm pots are now ready to send out to you already rooted for Spring. Including: Star of Bethlehem, English Bluebell, Tenby daffodil, Single Snowdrop, Winter aconite, Snakeshead fritillary and Grape hyacinths. Check out the website for the individual details, with prices between £3.50 - £4.00 per pot.

The [Native bulb collection](#) for small gardens is a new addition containing an equal mix of our Spring favourites: English bluebell, Wild daffodil and the Single snowdrop. Choose either the 6 pot collection at £20 or 9 pot collection at £30.

Coming soon:

Potted Wild garlic - what a beautiful highlight to find Wild garlic in the woodlands in Spring, as the pure white flowers and bright green leaves offer a visual freshness and the unmistakable aroma of garlic hangs in the air. Plant Wild garlic in part shade or even in a shady container outdoors, ready to be used for your culinary creations!



Peat free growing:

We propagate the majority of our wildflower plants from our own seed collected from our own plants. If we need additional supplies, (sometimes our harvest is less than expected!) we buy seed from registered UK suppliers. All our seeds are sown in peat free compost in our unheated polytunnels.

The seedlings are transplanted by hand into our plug trays, again in peat free compost and then into 9cm pots or sequentially into larger pots.

We do buy in bulbs from UK suppliers, and some new stock each year, such as bare root shrubs or young plants, but always grown in the UK. We only use peat-free compost at the nursery to pot our plants on, and appreciate that some of the bare root plants may not start as peat free but we do our utmost to continue their journey with our peat free ethos.
