



Think pink this Spring:

Moving into April and May more colour starts to appear in the wildflower garden. Just coming into flower are some of our favourite pink wildflowers of Spring; the delicate [Snakeshead fritillary](#), and [Cuckoo flower](#). Both are now in stock and it is a perfect time to plant so they will continue to flower, spread over time and reappear year after year.

Both are ideal for a damp area in the garden and they will also grow through grass or a lawn, enjoying sun or part shade.

Don't forget that our pots of Snakeshead fritillary have 3 corms per pot!

Plants for part shade :

Wild garlic in 1 litre pots: [Wild garlic 3 rhizomes/pot](#) *Allium ursinum*

Looking for a shady plant then try Wild garlic, The fresh green leaves of our Wild garlic are now developing and smell fantastic. The flowers appear after the leaves, so now is an ideal time to plant to benefit from both the leaves and the flowers.

Plant outdoors in a damp, but not waterlogged area in shade or part shade. Or why not add to a container as the leaves and flowers can be used in the kitchen and the white flowers are lovely sprinkled on salads.

Wood anemone in 9cm pot: [Wood anemone](#) *Anemone nemerosa*

Wood anemone is a pretty woodland plant, that grows well in moist, well-

Star of Bethlehem in 9cm pot: [Star of Bethlehem](#) *Ornithogalum umbellatum*

These pure white star like flowers are unmistakable. Star of Bethlehem grows equally well in a container as in the border, but it can spread quickly. It is a lovely woodland plant however and forms a beautiful undercover.

Our Pond edge collection:

The pond edge collection is a selection of 6 x 9cm pots of wildflowers, specially chosen for the edge of a garden pond. The wildflowers selected will traditionally be found on a pond edge or water course, and do not need to be submerged within the pond. However the plants have developed to enjoy both wet and dry conditions, so will suit most areas around a garden pond. Check out the [website](#) for more details.
