Time to plant Wild garlic:

Our potted [Wild garlic](#) in 1 litre containers is now ready to order and it's an ideal time to plant a pot. We love the bright green leaves, which are just appearing and the flowers will be a little later from April.

Plant outdoors in a damp, but not waterlogged area in shade or part shade. Or why not add to a container.

Wild garlic smells amazing and both leaves and flowers can be used in the kitchen, or they are fantastic to help attract pollinators to your garden.

Make your own Wild garlic butter, that will keep and remind you of Spring: :

- Chop a good handful of garlic leaves (25g) and mix with juice from 1/2 lemon.
- Beat into a 250g block of butter at room temperature
- Pat the butter onto cling film, wrap and roll into a cylinder.
- Twist the clingfilm to secure at both ends to seal.
- Keep in the fridge or freezer and use as needed.
- Lovely at a Summer BBQ!
